Paycheck Walkthrough

If you are working or once you start working, it is important to understand your paycheck. Understanding this helps you plan better. If you know what you're earning per week, you can make better decisions about spending and saving. Below is an example of how to understand gross pay, net pay, and deductions. If you are already familiar with these concepts, you can move to the paycheck activity on the next page.

To better understand, let's start with a simple example. **Imagine** you have a job that pays you \$12 per hour, and you work 40 hours in a week. How much do you think you'd earn? Let's calculate it together:

 $12 \times 40 \text{ hours} = 480 \text{ (gross pay)}$

This is what we call your **gross pay**. It's the total amount you earned before any money is taken out. Money is taken out of your paycheck due to something called deductions.

Deductions are money taken out of your paycheck for taxes, insurance, or other reasons. Everyone who pays taxes will have deductions on their paycheck.

So, for example, let's say **\$100** is taken out of your paycheck for taxes. These taxes help pay for things like roads, schools, and other services. So, your pay would look like this:

Gross Pay: **\$480**

Deductions: \$100

To figure out your net pay, the amount of money you actually get to take home, we do this math:

Gross Pay - Deductions = Net Pay

So, in our example:

\$480 - \$100 = \$380 (net pay)

Your net pay, the money you actually get to take home, would be \$380. Understanding this helps you plan how you need and want to use your money.
