

# Questions for Schedule

This tool helps you learn how to review a work schedule and to think about time. Using the Sample Work Schedule, answer some of these questions.

## **Beginning Questions:**

What days of the week does Amina work?

How many people are working on Thursday?

What days does Cameron have off?

How many hours is Taylor working this week?

Who has the opening shift(s) (starting work at 8:00 AM) on Saturday?

Who has the closing shift(s) (ending work at 8:00 PM) on Wednesday?

### **Critical Thinking Questions:**

Who works the most hours this week?

Who works the least hours this week?

If Jake needs help during his shift on Tuesday, who is he working with that he could ask for help?

If Cameron is sick can't work their shift on Thursday, who can they ask to cover their shift?

On Saturday, if Amina takes a break at 2:30, can Morgan also take a break at that time? Why or why not?

### **Problem-Solving Questions:**

Cameron starts work on Thursday and notices Jake isn't there, what can he do?

If Griffin realizes he has a conflict on Wednesday, what days can he offer to a coworker when trying to switch shifts?

Taylor has a 30-minute bus ride to work. On Sundays, the bus schedule comes 15 minutes past every hour (ex: 1:15 PM, 2:15 PM, 3:15 PM, 4:15 PM, etc.). What time does she need to take the bus to make sure she gets to work before her start time?

Cameron likes to plan to be five minutes early to work for his shifts. He gets home from class around 11:00 AM and it takes him about 20 minutes to drive to work. What is the latest he needs to leave?
