## **Volunteer Scenario - Food Drive**

Jamie notices some classmates don 't have enough food at lunch and realizes others may have food needs too. Jamie wants to have a food drive but isn't sure where to start.

**Prompts:** Who should Jamie talk to get started? Where should the food drive be held? When might we have the food drive? How might you communicate or market the food drive?

## **Volunteer Scenario - Donations**

Zane loves animals and recently visited a local animal shelter. Zane talked with a staff person who shared the shelter was crowded and low on supplies. Zane wants to help by having a donation drive, where can Zane start?

**Prompts:** Who should Zane talk to? How might you decide what is needed? Where should the drive be held? How might you communicate what's needed or where items can be dropped off?

## **Volunteer Scenario - Cleanup**

Aminah visits a local park and notices that it's often littered with trash, making it less safe and enjoyable. Aminah wants to help by organizing a cleanup and needs help.

**Prompts:** Does Aminah need permission to cleanup the park? Who will help cleanup? How might you raise awareness about the event?
