## Project: Transformation 2.0 Call for Applicants



Ohio was recently selected as a core state for the Employment First State Leadership Mentoring Program by the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Disability Employment Policy. Through this partnership, Ohio will receive expert technical assistance to support up to eight agencies (both public and private) in transforming their facility-based services to community-based employment and day supports.

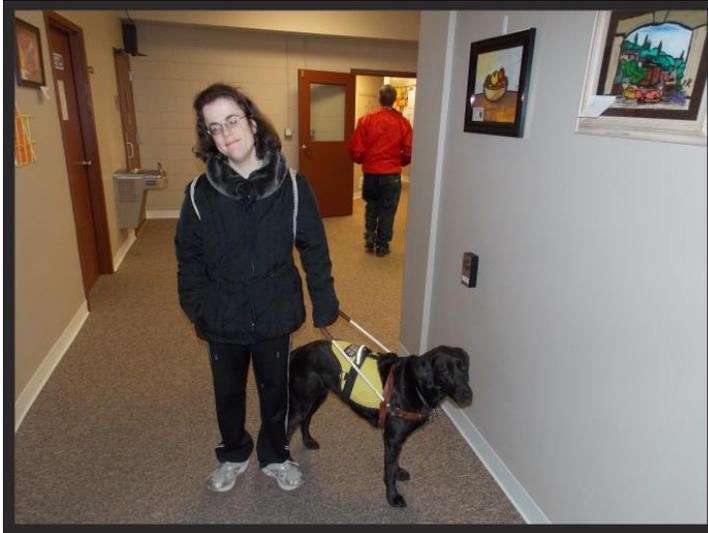
