

Exploring Postsecondary Options - Scoring Key

Students have been asked the below questions and selected responses in a worksheet. Each response corresponds with multiple postsecondary options. Below are the same questions the students have along with a parenthesis after each answer showing a corresponding postsecondary option. Use this information to fill in the table on the student's worksheet. Once finished, count the marks in each column and enter the totals for each letter. The column(s) with the highest totals show which postsecondary options students may want to explore.

Example: For Question 1:

1. How many years of education beyond high school are you willing to complete for a job in your chosen field?

1 to 2 years (A & E)

2 to 3 years (A & B)

4 or more years (A, B, C & D)

If the student chose 2 to 3 years, put a mark in column A and a mark in column B.

Closer to home **(A, B, C & E)**

Farther away **(B, C & D)**

4. Do you prefer to learn in an environment with many other students, or with only a small group of other students?

Bigger group **(A, C & D)**

Smaller group **(A, B, C & E)**

5. Do you prefer to learn new things in a classroom or on a job site?

Classroom **(A, C & E)**

Job site **(B, D & E)**

6. How important is it to you for your education setting to have extracurricular activities such as clubs and sports that you could participate in?

Very important **(A & C)**

Somewhat important **(A, C, D & E)**

Not important **(A, B, C, D & E)**

7. Do you prefer to live in your current home while you continue your education or do you prefer to live with other students (in a dorm or barracks, for example).

Live at home **(A, B, C & E)**

Live with other students **(C & D)**

8. How important is it to you to earn money while completing your education?

Very Important **(B & D)**

Somewhat important **(A, B, C, D & E)**

Not important **(A, C & E)**

9. Do you learn better in an environment with a clear structure and rules, or do you prefer a less structured environment that offers more independence but also requires higher personal responsibility?

Clear structure and rules **(B & D)**

Less structured **(A, C & E)**
