

School Scenario - School Supplies

You notice some classmates don't have school supplies like notebooks, pens, or folders which makes it hard for them to do their work. You want to help and have thought about reaching out to local businesses for donations.

Prompts: Who should you talk to? How can you get others to help? What do you need to do next? How are you planning to communicate?

Community Scenario - Garden

You notice a space within the park that is not being used and are thinking about building a community garden of vegetables and flowers.

Prompts: Do you need permission to start a garden? If so, who could you contact and ask? Who will help you start the garden? How might you raise awareness and seek donations to start?

Work Scenario - Positivity Corner

You have noticed your coworkers and other employees are feeling stressed and low. You want to help improve morale at work and have an idea to make a "Positivity Board" where people can post thank you notes and positive messages to each other.

Prompts: Who should you talk to? How will you decide what is needed? Where should the board be located? How might you start the board and keep it going?
